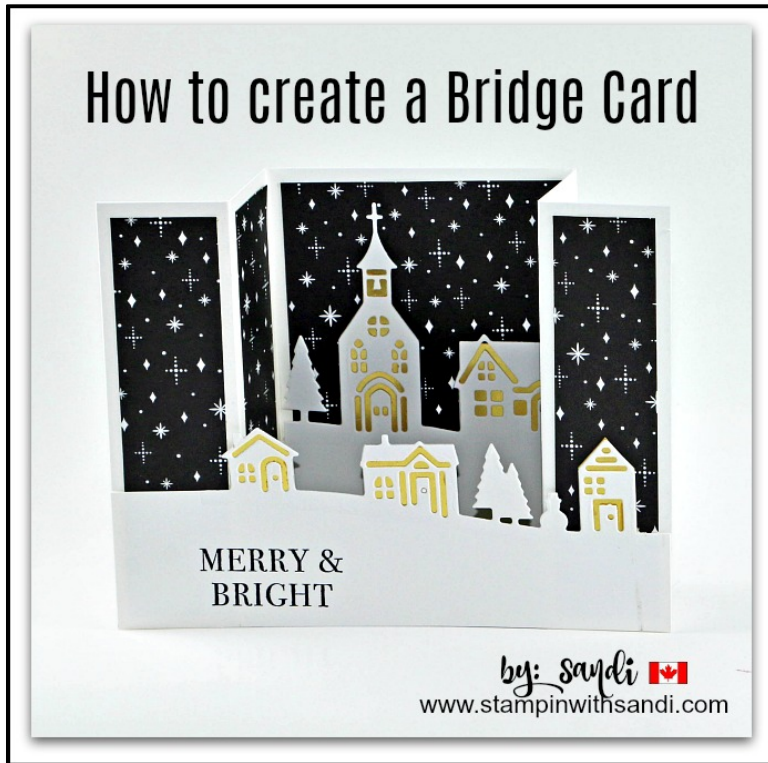


How to Create a Bridge Card

With Hearts Come Home from - Stampin' Up!

Technique: Folding Cards

Level: Beginner/Intermediate



TIME: 20- 25 Minutes

STAMPS:

Hearts Come Home

#145413 – wood

#145416 – clear

#146065 - wood bundle

#146068 – clear bundle

(bundle includes the stamps and dies and provides a 10% discount).

INKS:

Archival Basic Black #140931

ACCESSORIES:

Big Shot #143263

Magnetic Platform #130658

(Post It Notes to hold dies in place)

Hometown Greetings Edgelits #144671

Dimensionals #104430

Stampin Trimmer #126889

Multipurpose Glue #110755 or

Fine Tip Glue Pen #138309

Snail Adhesive #104332, Tear and Tape #138995 or Fast Fuse #129026

Stampin Scrub #126200 and Stampin Mist #102394

CARD STOCK AND DESIGNER PAPER:

Thick Whisper White #140272

4-1/4 x 8 score and fold at: 1-1/4, 2-1/2, 5-1/2 and 6-3/4
- card base

Merry Little Christmas Designer Paper
#144621

4" high, 6-3/4" wide (watch the design on the paper)
Cut at: 1", 1", 2-3/4", 1" leaving 1" – card fronts

Whisper White #100730

3-1/2 x 10
From the bottom left corner, Place a mark up the side at 1-3/8"
From the bottom left corner, Place a mark at 7", then at 7" place a mark up 3/4" – Bridge
- Once you cut the bridge, use the remaining piece to cut the church strip - watch the video on how to do this.



DIRECTIONS:

- 1 – Cut and score the card base.
 - 2 – Cut the Designer Paper and use Snail adhesive to attach the panels to the card front.
 - 3 – Cut the Bridge and the inside church strips from the Whisper White card stock.
 - 4 – Lay the houses over the pieces of Gold Foil and trace around them.
 - 5 – Cut out the gold foil pieces, staying inside the trace lines so they are 1/8” smaller than the houses.
 - 6 – Use multipurpose glue or the Fine Tip Glue Pen to attach the gold foil pieces to the back of the houses so they all look like the lights are on.
 - 7 – Lay the center part of the card base over the church strip and use the center two score lines to place a pencil cutting mark on either side of the church strip.
 - 8 – Stay inside the pencil lines and use the Stampin Trimmer to trim the ends of the church strip.
- TIP** - The video goes into detail on these cuts.
- TIP** – you should be able to place the church strip in the center of the card and close it, without causing a “raised bump” in the center, it should lay flat, if it doesn’t, trim it a bit more.
- 9 – Use Dimensionals to place the church strip in the center of the card.
 - 10 – Use the ruler and place pencil cut marks on either end of the bridge strip so that it’s 5-3/8” long.
 - 11 – Use the Stampin Trimmer to trim both ends.
 - 12 – Use the Black Ink and stamp the sentiment in the bottom left corner of the bridge strip.
 - 13 – When the ink is dry, place Fast Fuse or Tear and Tape (stronger than Snail), on the two ends of the bridge and attach them to either end of the card.
 - 14 – Clean the stamp with the Stampin Scrub and Mist.
